

Privacy Policy E-Kaliteri LTD

The Administrator of Your personal data is E-Kaliteri LTD, based in the United Kingdom, Unit 10, Enterprise Court, Farfield Park, Manvers, Rotherham, South Yorkshire, England, S63 5DB. The recipient of personal data will be employees or partners of E-Kaliteri LTD who are involved in the performance of your service or order.

Personal data will be processed for the period necessary for the performance of the contract, and after that period for the purposes and for the period and to the extent required by law or until the withdrawal of consent. The data will be processed in accordance with the policy and regulation of RODO and applicable data protection laws:

What data are being processed?

Who will receive the data?

In the event of an ICO (The Information Commissioner's Office) audit, your data may be made available to employees.

The data processed may be entrusted to or accessed by trusted partners only for the purposes necessary for the proper functioning of the School.
